## **About the University of Southampton**

The University of Southampton is an international university with a global reputation for excellence in leading edge research and high quality teaching. # PhD study opportunities

Standard PhD programmes involve three years of full time independent research. Some academic areas offer 4 year integrated PhD programmes (iPhD) which may involve taught modules as well as independent research.

#### **Accommodation**

We guarantee University accommodation to international students for up to two years of study. We offer a range of self-catering accommodation options with easy access to all of the University's campuses.

### **University facilities**

The University's learning environment includes a library on every campus, with online access to many resources accessible via Wi-Fi. The Centre for Language Study offers English language support all year round.

The Students' Union offers a wide range of social and sporting activities including over 120 student-run clubs and societies. The University also hosts three professional arts venues - a concert hall, a theatre and an art gallery – on its Highfield campus.

### **Living costs**

We recommend around £10,500 for each year of postgraduate study to cover living expenses such accommodation, food, books and leisure activities.

# Xiamen University – University of Southampton PhD Scholarships: Terms and Conditions

### **Funding**

Up to 7 scholarships are expected to be available for 2015 entry. The scholarships cover full tuition fee costs for each year of the PhD programme for up to 4 years.

To be eligible for this scholarship, candidates must also successfully apply for maintenance funding of a minimum of USD 1,500 per month from the Chinese Scholarship Council (CSC) or another source.

### **Entry requirements**

Each PhD programme has particular academic entry requirements and English language requirements.

- Academic entry requirements
  - Typical academic entry requirements are a Bachelor degree with a grade of 2:1 or equivalent Some programmes may also require a Masters degree with good grades.
- English language requirements

These range from IELTS 6.0 to IELTS 7.0 overall, with particular grades required in each component. General entry requirements can be found at:

Applicants must have met the English language requirements when they apply for the scholarship.

### **Application process**

- All applicants must be nominated by Xiamen University.
- Nominated applicants should complete the University's online postgraduate application form which is available on the website: <a href="https://www.southampton.ac.uk/research/phd/apply.shtml">www.southampton.ac.uk/research/phd/apply.shtml</a>
- In the Funding section of the application form applicants should state that they wish to be considered for the Xiamen Southampton PhD Scholarship scheme.
- Guidance about the supporting documents required is available on the How to Apply section of each Faculty's Postgraduate Study website.
- For many programmes applicants must submit a research proposal, and are required to discuss their topic with academic staff in advance in order to identify a suitable project and/or potential supervisor.
- Academic staff will review the applications and nominate appropriate candidates to the University's PhD Scholarships Selection Panel which will take place in February 2015.
